THE WORKSHOP

Workshop participants will be expected to attend the whole of the meeting and play a role as either author, chairperson or discussant.

The Short Course

The meeting will incorporate a short course aimed at PhD students and junior researchers. [Professor Andrew Jones](#) (University of York) will lead this on April 6th 2010.

The main workshop will begin on the evening of 6th April and finish on the evening of 9th April and includes meals and three nights accommodation for those outside Melbourne.

SUBMISSION OF PAPERS

Papers for the 2010 workshop will be selected on the basis of full drafts. The deadline for submitting papers in [1st November 2009](#). Submitted papers should be unpublished and not accepted for publication in a peer reviewed journal.

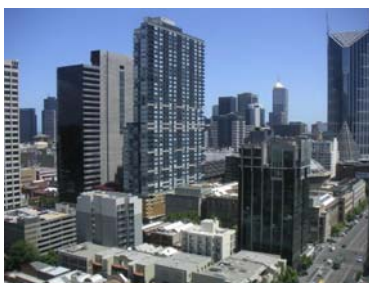
